Exhibitor Rules and Terms of Agreement

1. Booth (s) will not be reserved without a 50% deposit, which is non-refundable. Final payment is due July 1, 2010. Should the exhibitor decide to cancel or terminate this agreement before July 1, 2010, the 50% fee shall be retained by the show producer. The producer reserves the right to reject any applicant at any time by refunding the applicant the amount paid for the exhibit space. Unless by written agreement, by both exhibitor and producer, this agreement is non cancelable.
2. Booths will be assigned in order received. Booth # preference _____ 2nd choice _____ 3rd choice _____
3. Liability for any loss to the exhibitors shall not be the responsibility of the producer or the facility. Exhibitors are encouraged to carry insurance, covering trade shows and fairs, which insures their goods and exhibits against loss or damage. The exhibitor also agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the show producer, it's volunteers and employees, and the facility, against any and all claims arising out of acts of the exhibitor and/or his representative, or out of products, services or activities within or outside the exhibitor booth area. Exhibitors are responsible for damage they cause to the facility, including labor charges to repair such damage. Exhibitors will be billed for such damage at an amount determined by the facility.
4. Exhibitors must conform to all local Police, City, Fire laws, health regulations, electrical codes, and other local, state and federal laws and regulations. It is the exhibitors' responsibility to acquire any permits necessary to meet local regulations. Exhibitors must maintain 10' aisles for fire escape. All materials used in the exhibit hall must be flameproof and fire resistant. No burning of any materials will be permitted.
5. The following practices are prohibited: noisy electrical, musical or other mechanical apparatus interfering with other exhibitors. Canvassing or distributing any material outside the exhibitors own space, entering another booth without permission, taking photographs, audio or video without the permission of the show producer.
6. Exhibitors must have booth assembles and running before 9:30 August 7, 2010. Dismantling of the exhibits before the close of the show August 8 at 5pm is strictly prohibited. All exhibits must be dismantled and removed from the facility by 6:30pm August 8.
7. The show producer may cancel this agreement if cancellation is due to facility damage, snow, strike, act of war, act of God, state of emergency, or any other reason and the exhibitor agrees not to hold the show, its' producer, volunteers or employees liable for damage or injury caused therefrom. The show producer shall determine an equitable basis for refund of such portion of the exhibit booth fees as is possible, after consideration of expenditures and commitments already made.
8. No more than one vendor per booth, without permission from show producer.
